To work with external partners both locally and nationally

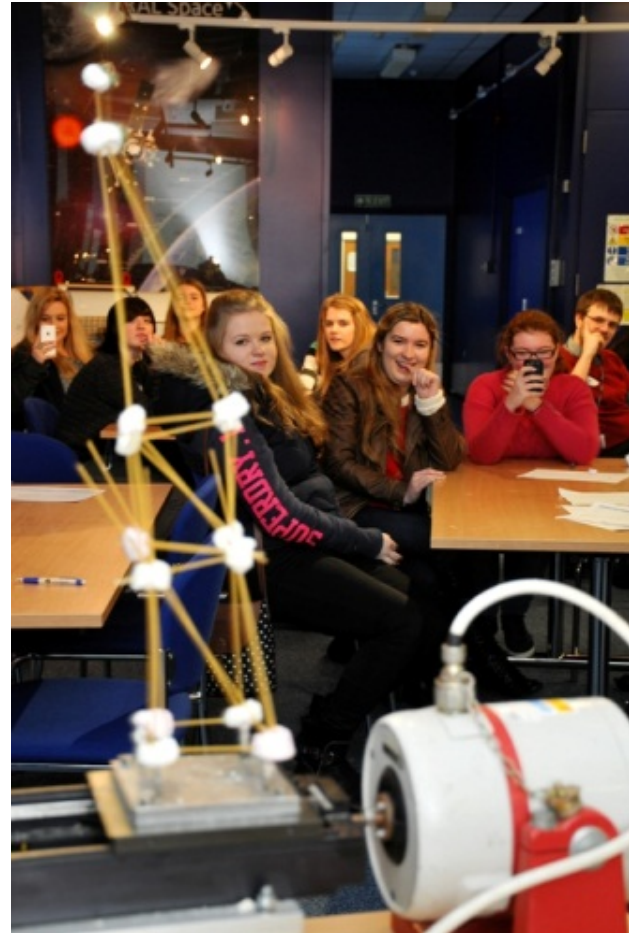
Partnerships for schools events
